Sparkling wine and champagne

Piper-Heidsieck Brut N.V **Bottle**

Shows notes of hawthorn blossom, summer apple and pear; this regular gold medal winning 'cuvée' won the Non-vintage Trophy at the International Wine Challenge in 2006.

Veuve Du Vernay (Bin end) **Bottle**

Pale Straw in colour with long lasting elegant bubbles. French and lively on the nose, with good fruit and persistent length. A harmonious finish.

2.Sant' Orsola Prosecco N.V **Glass** **Bottle**

Made from 100% Prosecco grown in the Veneto region of north-east Italy with its particularly mild climate. Fine, persistent, soft fizz surrounds the typical fruit spectrum of apples, pears with a hint of peach

Los Romeros Merlot, Central Valley **Glass** **Bottle**

This wine is soft, juicy and shows spiced plum and dark berry fruit; it has a velvety outlook and is quite light-bodied.

This spicy, fruity Shiraz is sourced mainly from Riverland and Sunraysia. The palate shows excellent varietal typicity with dark berry fruit flavours, mingled with a light

Bodegas Salentein Portillo Malbec, Argentina

Bottle

This rich Malbec is infused with tempting aromas of ripe black fruits and plums. Velvety and soft on the palate with rich fruit flavours.

Altano, Tinta Roriz-Touriga Franca, Douro

Bottle

This rich, flavoursome wine is made using two of the traditional Port grape varieties, Tinta Roriz and Touriga Franca from specially selected vineyards. A wine with deep colour, spicy fruit and rich, velvety tannins on the finish.

Chianti, Ruffino

Bottle

When Chianti became a DOCG in 1984, it was a bottle of Ruffino Chianti that wore the first warranty strip bearing the number 00000001. This was the first wine produced by the founders Ilario and Leopoldo. Made exclusively of Sangiovese, it shows floral and fruity notes that lead towards spicy scents of white pepper and hazelnuts.

Flagstone Dragon Tree Cabernet Sauvignon-Shiraz-Pinotage, Western Cape

Bottle

Dominated by Cabernet Sauvignon with other varieties such as Shiraz and Pinotage in the blend this is a complex and concentrated wine not made to a formula, but with the desire to create a great 'Cape Red'. Shows rich, dark-fruit, smoky-oak, with notes of mint and sweet and spicy undertones.

Fleurie Les Muriennes, Thorin

Bottle

Fleurie is known as the 'Queen of Beaujolais'. It is the most quintessential and versatile of the 'crus'. A wine showing good fruit and delicacy.

Fetzer Zinfandel, California

Bottle

This is a high-quality, classic, claret-styled Zinfandel. The fruit is sourced from Mendocino and Amador Counties, where the variety typically develops a spicy, black pepper character; 5% Petite Sirah is included in the final blend. Aged in mainly American oak barrels for 11 months.

Château Lamothe-Cissac, Cru Bourgeois Haut-Médoc

Bottle

An excellent château, owned by the Fabre family, situated between Pauillac and Saint-Estèphe. Traditionally vinified and aged in oak barriques, 20% of which are new. Fine, aromatic, with a ripe cherry character enlivened by liquorice and vanilla. 90 points from Wine Enthusiast Magazine.

Rosé

Los Romeros Merlot Rosé, Central Valley **Glass** **Bottle**

Fresh raspberry and strawberry aromas and flavours with gentle acidity. (3)

Pale vermilion in colour, this is a fresh and fragrant rosé with fruity tones of cherry and other red fruits backed by floral notes of violets and roses

Los Romeros Sauvignon Blanc, Central Valley **Glass** **Bottle**

As an everyday drinking Sauvignon Blanc this wine represents excellent value. Aromas of herbs, grass, yellow plum, green pepper and a zippy lemon acidity

The Gourmet Chardonnay, South Australia **Glass** **Bottle**

Fruit-driven Chardonnay, unoaked with zesty, citrusy fruit and a structure made for food.

Rare Vineyards Marsanne-Viognier, Pays d'Oc **Bottle**

A blend of Rhône varieties grown in the warm vineyards of the d'Oc region of southern France. Unoaked the emphasis is on fresh, lively citrus fruit backed by notes of peach blossom

Domain de Ricaud Blanc, Bordeaux, France (Bin end) **Bottle**

Crisp, juicy, citrus fruit flavours and a lengthy finish, this makes a good match to seafood.

Torres Viña Esmeralda Catalunya **Bottle**

The use of the aromatic Muscat with the equally spicy Gewürztraminer produces a wine which is both floral and fragrant while at the same time retaining a crisp, elegant palate

Touraine Sauvignon, Domaine Trotignon **Bottle**

From close to the city of Touraine, made from the most famous of Loire grapes, comes this zesty, gooseberry-scented wine with a dry, crisp finish

Castell de Raimat Albariño, Costers del Segre **Bottle**

The fashionable Albariño grape variety does not always have to come from the Rías Baixas region! Shows delicate aromas of citrus, dried flowers and spice with a hint of sweet vanilla and dried fruit; the palate is well-rounded and the finish citrusy and refreshing.

Nobilo Southern Rivers Sauvignon Blanc, East Coast **Bottle**

A fresh, grassy-gooseberry Sauvignon Blanc from the East Coast region. This wine is an excellent, and affordable, introduction to the rest of the Nobilo range, yet one of high quality

Mâcon-Lugny Montvallon, E. Loron et Fils **Bottle**

A dry, ripe, unoaked yet full-flavoured wine with good concentration of fruit, firm palate, and a long, steely finish.

Sweet Wine

Muscat de Beaumes de Venise, Cave des Vignerons **Bottle**

Produced from the distinctive Muscat à Petits Grains grape grown in vineyards set against the spectacular backdrop of the jagged Dentelles de Montmirail. Rich and concentrated, it makes an ideal dessert wine.

Orange Muscat and Flora, Brown Brothers, Australia. Half Bottle (Bin End) **Bottle**

Delicious aromas of orange blossom on the nose with a yummy citrus and spicy note on the tongue.

Casillero del Diablo Cabernet Sauvignon, Central Valley

This is the flagship Casillero wine; rich and concentrated. Blackcurrant, black cherry and plum married together with toasty-oak, 70% of the blend is aged in small American oak barrels for eight months, as well as vanilla and a touch of mocha. The 2010 vintage was recently described by Matthew Jukes as, 'the finest value Cabernet Sauvignon on the Planet'.

A Sauvignon Blanc that is well-balanced between green, grassy, herbaceous and tropical flavours; it is crisp and refreshing and has an attractive lemony finish

The traditional Garganega grape is blended with the rare, but highly-prized, Trebbiano di Soave which improves both the fruit and aroma of the finished blend. Dry yet with soft acidity and a rounded almondy palate
